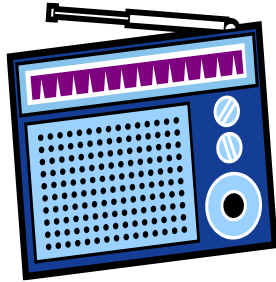

Reminders for Inclement Weather days



Plan ahead:

- * Provide your school with written instructions on where your child(ren) should go if busses leave early or the school is closed (for grades K-8).
- * Discuss with your child(ren) how long they should wait for the bus before returning indoors. We suggest 15 minutes maximum.
- * Bookmark our website and tune your radio.
- * **Always have a back-up plan!**

In bad weather:

- * **It is ultimately the decision of parents/guardians whether or not to send their children to school in bad weather.**

East Parry Sound

East Parry Sound is quite a large geographic area. It includes: Powassan, Nipissing and Trout Creek in the north; Commanda, Restoule, Golden Valley, Arnstein, and Port Loring in the north-west, South River, Sundridge, Magnetawan, and Burk's Falls in the centre, and Kearney, Katrine, Emsdale, Sprucedale, and Novar in the south.

- * Please do not call NPSSTS or bus operators: lines must be kept free for updates on road and safety issues.
- * **Buses cancelled in the morning are also cancelled for the afternoon: if you bring your child(ren) to school, you must pick them up.**

Safety starts at the stop!

- * Don't play on snow banks
- * Don't throw snowballs
- * Dress warmly
- * Wear items with reflective strips or bright colours
- * Be outside at your stop a few minutes early, even if it's at the end of your driveway. This keeps buses on time, so no one waits long in the cold.
- * **Reminder: Winter sports equipment (i.e. skis/poles, skates, hockey sticks, etc.) are not allowed on the bus**
